and will strengthen your frame.

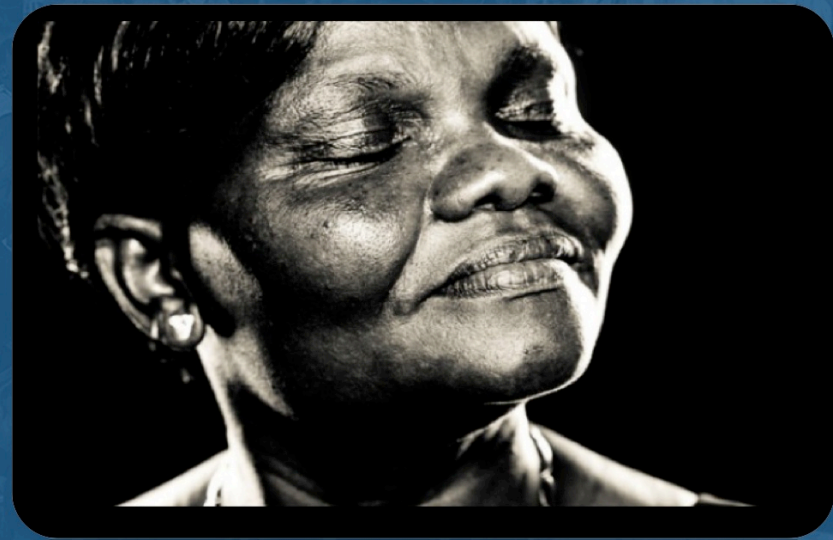
You will be like a well-watered garden,
